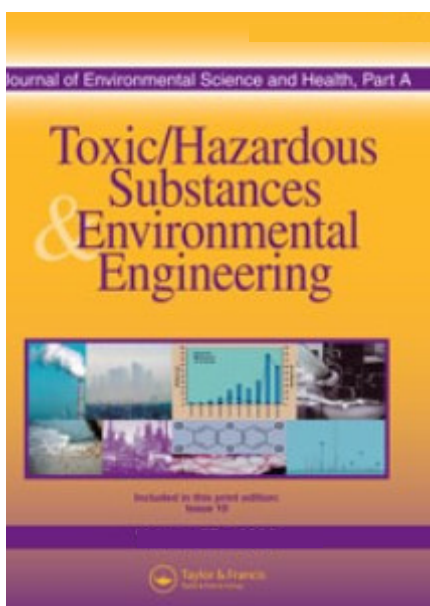
## Aims & Scope

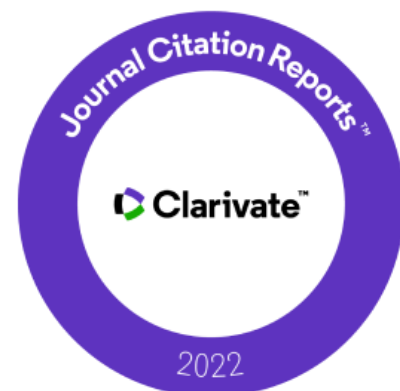
